- I. Widespread participation
- II. A sense of political efficacy
- III. Multiplicity of voluntary organization

In civic culture political participation is considered legitimate and individuals are encouraged and confident to take part in the democratic process. They seek to influence decision making and political choices through active participation in politics. Almond and Verba have observed, "Whether or not one believes himself capable of influencing a local or national regulation depends a lot on who he is within his own country. If he has more education, higher status, or is male, he is clearly more likely to consider himself competent."


