1.3.1 - Sarbati Devi Women's College is a general Degree College with Arts from the session 1984-85 & Science from the session 2017-18 having Honours in Economics, Education, Political Science, Odia, History, Home Science, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany & Zoology. There is no technical course within the curriculum of the College. The institute makes every possible effort to develop an action plan for effective implementation of the curriculum. Immediately after admission process is over in the beginning of the academic session, students are required to attend orientation classes to be well versed with the curriculum. They are provided with College Calendar having the detailed syllabus. Library facilities are available to all the students where they can borrow text books, reference books and journals. Students also attend proctorial classes in a small group once in a week where their problems can be addressed. Regular monthly tests and test examinations as well as group discussions, seminars etc. are held for effective implementation of the curriculum.

The members of staff of various teaching departments conduct the departmental meetings and develop academic plans for the session for effective implementation of the curriculum. They divide the syllabus into various units to be covered within the time frame, keeping in view the number of working days available. They also follow the academic calendar supplied by the department of higher education and the university supplemented by the plan of action of the College.

<u>Gender Studies</u>:- The College is meant for girls. It gives utmost importance to the gender studies. Though the institution is an affiliated college and has no freedom for introducing new courses on women's studies, the college regularly organizes seminars, symposiums, extra mural lectures on issues pertaining to women. Students eagerly participate and present their views and papers.

<u>Environment and Sustainability</u>:- Environment Studies is a compulsory subject in the final year at the degree level. It enriches the curriculum by creating awareness among the students. Students also respond to the issues in the form of projects & seminar papers. The College conducts essay, debate, slogan writing, drawing and painting competitions pertaining to environment and sustainability.

<u>Human Values and Professional Ethics</u>:- Human rights is a part of the curriculum in the degree level in political science pass & honours. The College organizes seminars and workshops inviting experts on this issue, particularly

human values & human rights violation against women. The College observes the 10^{th} December as Human Rights Day. Apart from human rights, the College organizes workshops to uphold human values and professional ethics by giving moral lessons.
