- 6.5 Internal Quality Assurance System
- 6.5.1 Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes.

Details of two best practices followed by the institution:

(a) To plant trees in the Campus and make the environment free from pollution.

NSS & Red Cross wings of the College are advised to undertake tree plantation in the College Campus by their volunteers under the guidance of Programme Officers. The volunteers are taught about the benefit of plantation and its effects on our environment. Rajgangpur is an industrial town. There are so many big and small industries in and around Rajgangpur and they are responsible for air pollution. The volunteers in particular and the students in general are made to be conscious about its demerits and how to make the air free from pollution. So such programme are regularly conducted in the College Campus to plant more and more trees. The programme is quite successful for the last two years.

(b) To make awareness among the girls of the College to teach illiterate and dropout boys & girls of the locality.

Rajgangpur is a semi-urban area. Many people are living in slums and the children are either not admitted to the School or they are leaving the School half way through. So, it is a great social problem. A section of the people are deprived of education. So, to bring them to the main stream of society, the students of S. D. Women's College are educated through NSS & Red Cross to teach these illiterate and drop out students of the slum dwellers to make a healthy balance between the developed and the underdeveloped.
