5. Green Practices

Students, staff using

S. D. Women's College is situated in a semi-urban area in Rajgangpur Municipality. As it is situated in the heart of the town, around 50% of the students are coming to the College on foot and since it is a semi-urban town, the roads are pedestrian friendly. Around 40% of the students use bicycles and 10% of the students use public transport system. Only 50% of the members of staff use two wheelers, 30% of the staff use public transport and the rest are pedestrians.

The campus is almost plastic free. But the College is yet to achieve paperless office, however steps are being taken to achieve the target in a few years as soon as the system of e-Governance is implemented. Every year volunteers of the NSS & YRC and cadets of NCC plant trees in the College campus. However at present Green landscaping with trees and plants is affected due to construction in the college campus and also rise in temperature in this area.
