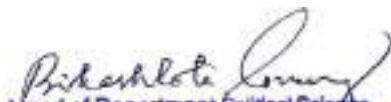

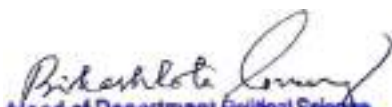

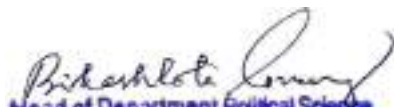

The seminar aimed to create awareness and understanding among students about the historical evolution, struggles, and achievements of the Dalit movement in India. The session began with a welcome address and brief introduction of the resource person, Prof. Hemant Kumar Panda, Reader in Political Science, P.S. College, Bargaon, who shared his valuable insights on the topic, highlighting the social, political, and constitutional aspects of Dalit empowerment.

The seminar presentation was conducted by the students of Political Science in PowerPoint format. The main paper was presented by +3 Second Year students—Shanti Minz, Tanu Hemron, and Sanjan Tirkey—who explained the origin, objectives, and different phases of the Dalit movement. 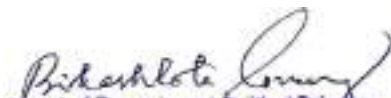
